The purpose of this memorandum is to request that the Alaska Department of Law and the United States Department of Justice notify the United States District Court that interest and lapsed money (*Exxon Valdez Settlement Fund*, i.e., GeFONSI fund) will be used to fund the following:

Additional funds for approved Project 01190, Construction of a Linkage Map for the Pink Salmon Genome, in the amount of \$4,300 for Alaska Department of Fish and Game.

This court notice will be combined with the three small parcels. I sent the documentation for these parcels to you on April 20, 2001. The three small parcels which are being purchased by USFWS are:

The money to fund the three small parcels will come from interest and lapsed money in the NRDAR fund.

The total amount for Court Notice #7 is **\$51,800**.



The United States and the State of Alaska ("the Governments") hereby jointly notify the Court of their intent to expend \$51,800.00 in interest that has accrued on monies disbursed from the EXXON VALDEZ Oil Spill Settlement Account for the purposes described below.

The sum of \$4,300.00 will be provided to the State of Alaska to fund necessary natural resource damage assessment and restoration activities during federal

1 fiscal year 2001.¹

2 The sum of \$47,500.00 will be provided to the United States to fund the
3 acquisition of three small parcels (KAP 2006, 2067 and 2068) comprising approximately
4 30 acres of land on Kodiak Island within the Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge.²

5 The total of these expenditures – \$51,800.00 – is available to the
6 Governments from interest that has accrued from investments on funds previously
7 disbursed by the Court and placed in the Natural Resource Damage Assessment and
8 Restoration Fund managed by the Department of the Interior and the Exxon Valdez
9 Settlement Expendable Trust Account managed by the Alaska Department of Revenue.
10 Accordingly, the Governments will not request a disbursement of monies from the
11 Investment Fund to fund these restoration activities.

14 A complete summary of the Council's activities since approval of the
15 settlement was appended to our Second Application, filed January 19, 1993, as Attachment
16 B, and interim updates of activities appeared as Attachments to each of the Governments'

19 Valdez Oil Spill Trustee Council voted unanimously to expend this sum to provide
20 additional funds to previously approved Project 01190 (Construction of a linkage Map for

21 ² The July 5, 2000 and the January 16, 2001 resolutions of the Exxon Valdez Oil
22 Spill Trustee Council evidencing the unanimous decision of its members to expend this


