Pilot projects for both NHD and NWI have been completed. The pilot deliverables were received from the contractor NV5 geospatial and reviewed by USGS and USFWS. Calibrations were completed and both NHD and NWI have been given the go-ahead to move forward on full project production.

USGS and USFWS have finalized and implemented a cooperative agreement for USGS to complete all NHD quality control. They are finalizing an agreement for USGS to complete all WBD quality control.

USFWS and the State of Alaska have finalized and implemented a cooperative agreement for their work to support the data stewardship and outreach for the project.

Field work planning is in the final stages as we work through permits and authorizations with landowners and interested parties.
