1. Summary of Work Performed:

KRSA continues to provide outreach and public awareness of the project with a display board in their headquarters' lobby. Additionally, they contracted with Fish Alaska magazine to write a digital article educating the public about habitat restoration and angler access projects their

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organization has been involved with for the past 40 years. Article included a brief description of the Big Eddy project. The article will be published online in June.

2/9/24 Negotiations begun with Respec for Geotechnical Investigation work at Big Eddy

3/18/24 Geotechnical Investigation contract signed and executed

3/13/24 – Consultation with the Office of History and Archeology (OHA) revealed that they will require a cultural survey before site disturbance. OHA agreed to a phased approach:

- 1. Pedestrian survey without subsurface testing to look for depressions, structures, ruins, and graves (when the snow is mostly gone but the ground is frozen);
- 2. Interim report to OHA documenting effort including any additional recommendations to minimize effects;
- 3. Geotech work:
- 4. Intensive survey (transects and subsurface testing) of the Area of Potential Effect (APE) with an associated report; and
- 5. Construction activities.
- 4/3/24 Preliminary site visit for Geotech work (marking of potential borehole locations)
- 4/17/24 Kenai River Center permits received for Geotech drilling
- 4/24/24 Pedestrian survey completed by OHA
- 4/29/24 Memo received from OHA, no objection to proceeding with geotechnical investigation

2. Abstract:

The project is on schedule and this reporting period DPOR moved forward with the geotechnical investigation work at Big Eddy. The Office of History and Archeology (OHA) was consulted and revealed that they will require a cultural survey before site disturbance. Because the Geotech drilling needs to happen on frozen ground, OHA agreed to a phased approach to their survey. Permits were received from the Kenai River Center and drilling is slated to begin in May.
