I am requesting a reallocation of \$3248 from commodities and \$1802 from indirect costs, in the FY22 budget to \$5050 in equipment. Originally I budgeted a total of \$3,421 (\$2,200 from commodities + 55.5% indirect) in FY22 for a data-crunching PC computer. Due to lingering pandemic supply chain issues and technological advancements (Apple computers are about 5x faster now) since the proposal was approved, the expense for this data-crunching computer was far higher than budgeted. Classifying this purchase as equipment over \$5000, which is not subject to indirect charges, was more cost-effective than classifying the purchase as commodities under \$5000 which would include the 55.5% indirect charge. Furthermore, purchasing this much faster machine with Apple chips will obviate the need for a second data-cruncher in FY27 as was budgeted originally, saving the Council several thousand dollars.
